ORDINANCE 06-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE 04-01, RELATIVE TO ADOPTING THE UPDATED EDITION OF THE TEXAS ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, TEXAS FOOD ESTABLISHMENT RULES 2006, AS THE OFFICIAL CODE OF THE CITY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the city council hereby adopts the 2006 Texas Administrative Code, Title 25, Part 1, Chapter 229, Subchapter K.

RULE; 229.161, PURPOSE, The purpose of these rules is to safeguard public health and to provide to consumers food that is safe, unadulterated, and honestly presented.

WHEREAS, the City Council has retained an independent contractor(s) to conduct inspections within the corporate City limits; and

WHEREAS, the independent contractor(s) utilize updated versions of the codes which have been adopted as the official codes of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it desirable and proper to update the editions of the referenced codes as the official codes of the City,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, TEXAS:

Section 1

That the above recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2

The City Council hereby amends Ordinance 04-01, relative to the adoption of the official codes of the City, which shall hereinafter read as follows:

Section 3 Severability

If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part of provisions thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4 Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances

All ordinances, orders or resolutions heretofore passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Nevada, Texas, are hereby repealed to the extent that said ordinances, orders and resolutions, or parts thereof, are in conflict herewith.

Section 5 Effective Date

The City Council finds and determines that the passage of this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall become effective on and after the date of its adoption by the City Council.
