### Ordinance No. 10-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, TEXAS, CANCELING THE COUNCIL PORTION OF THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 08, 2010; DECLARING UNOPOSED STATUS FOR EACH CANDIDATE.**

WHEREAS: Ordinance 10-01 called for a General Election to be held on May08, 2010, for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor and two (2) Council Members for two year term each.

WHEREAS: Subchapter C. (a)(1), Section 2.052 (a)(1)(2), (b), Section 2.053 (a)(b) of the Texas Election Code, specifies that this subchapter applies to an election of officers of a political subdivision for each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed and that the authority responsible for having the official ballot prepared shall certify in writing that a candidate is unopposed if only one candidate's name is to be placed on the ballot for that office and no candidate's name is to be placed on the list of write in candidates for that office. On receipt of the certification, the governing body of the political subdivision may declare each unopposed candidate elected to the office. If a declaration is made, the election is not held.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEVADA, TEXAS:

Section 1: By Certification from the City Secretary, the City Council of the City of Nevada, Texas declares the unopposed candidate(s) elected to the office of Council Member.

Section 2: No Election will be held for the office of Council Member on May 08, 2010.

Section 3: A certificate shall be issued to the candidate after the date on which the canceled election would have been held.
